Eco Council

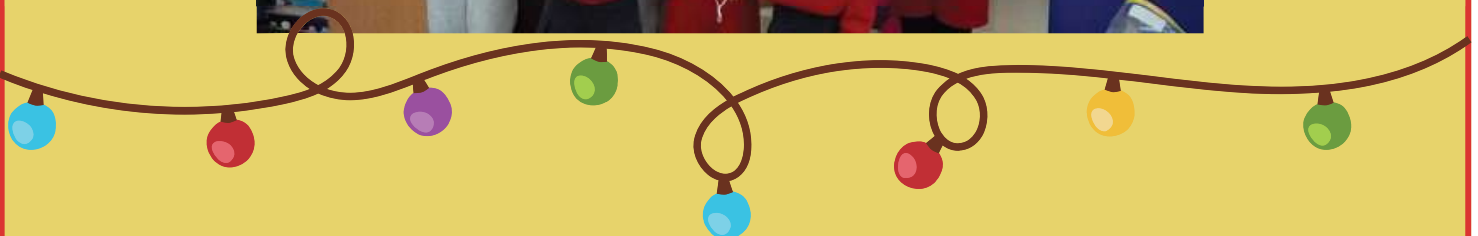
The Eco Council have been working together to do an environmental review of our school to help us focus on specific areas this year.
