English

- Use capital letters and punctuation accurately.
- Use time connectives to sequence events.
- Identify the features of instructional texts

Maths

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number.
- Recognise, compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = sign.

Science

Healthy Animals & Materials Matter

- Explore the useful properties of materials.
- Understand that exercise makes the heart work harder and is an essential part of a healthy lifestyle.

- Explore how we can make art inspired by the sounds we hear.

History

- To experience a modern approach to the risk of fire, compared with 350 years ago.
- What can we learn about events in the past from historical diaries?

- Use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

Geography

An Introduction to the basic concept of climate zones and mapping out hot and cold places globally. Comparing features in the North and South Poles and Kenya as well as in the local area. Learning the four compass points and the names and location of the seven continents.

Learn about the Great Fire of London from pictures and eye-witness reports and create a timeline of events. Generate questions and research the answers to write reports for a class newspaper. Find out about the famous diarists Samuel Pepys and John Evelyn. diary entries, including a realistic entry set during the Great Fire.
