

Year 5 Curriculum Planner Autumn 2025

English

Writing – Plan and write narrative stories using a range of sentence structures - inspired by Ancient Greek myths and the life of Alexander the Great.

Grammar – To understand what a sentence is and how to construct multi-phrase/clause sentences.

Reading – To develop the skills of inference, questioning and prediction.

Maths

Place value – read, write, order and round numbers to 1 000 000, determining the value of each digit.

Number operations – To develop formal methods for addition and subtraction.

Statistics – To read and interpret data, and draw line graphs.

Science

Changing Materials – To carry out controlled investigations.

Use data to create tables.

Forces - to design and carry out fair tests, make predictions and record results.

Art

Introduction to topography design and exploration on creating fonts and design.

<u>DT</u>

To understand how the four great inventions of China shaped the world.

<u>RE</u>

Christianity – ask and respond to questions about the Bible and identify its features.

Computing

Online safety and understanding how computers can be connected to form systems.

French

To give simple opinions and express likes and dislikes.

<u>Music</u>

To describe, compare and evaluate different types of music, beginning to use musical terms.

PSHE

To understand our rights and responsibilities in school and the roles we play in our community.

VALUES – This term we will be learning about and showing the values of **Respect and Cooperation**.

Geography

To learn about why people visit the Alps, focusing on Innsbruck's climate, human and physical features, and tourism. They will also learn to investigate local tourism, map recreational land use, and present findings to compare their locality with the Alps.

<u>History</u>

To learn about the key features of Ancient Greece, including its gods, city-states, democracy, and philosophy, and explore the lasting impact of its legacies.
