English

Use Read Write Inc. to recognise and blend sounds, read words and spot 'red words' (words that you can't sound out.)

Write a clear sentence using capital letters and full stops.

Maths

Count, read and write numbers from 0-10

Compare and order numbers, finding one more and one less.

Begin to understand tens and one's (place value).

Begin to add and subtract.

Science

Name basic body parts and explore the senses.

Name and describe different materials.

Art

Explore simple ways to make a print. Use line, shape, colour and texture to explore patterns.

DT

To use a knife and fork correctly. To make a fruit salad using cutlery.

RE

Explore Creation Stories and identify things that they find 'amazing' in the world

Recall the nativity story.

Geography

Developing mapping skills by locating familiar features on aerial photographs and creating simple maps.

History

Investigating the past within living memory by exploring personal chronology and using photographs to ask and answer questions about the past.

Computing

Online safety.

An introduction to technology and developing keyboard skills.

Music

Recognise rhythm and sing songs in unison.

P.E.

Use different apparatus to develop balance, coordination and footwork.

PSHE

Learning about our feelings, what it means to be a good friend and why we have classroom rules.

VALUES –Respect and Cooperation

We will be discussing what respect means and why it is important to be respectful. We will learn that co-operation means working together, listening to others, and helping each other to achieve a shared goal.
