<u>English</u>

Writing -

Narratives, poetry, non-chronological report.

Grammar –

Apostrophe's and comma's in a list. Past and present tense

Reading –

Make inferences based on a text. Compare the differences between fiction and non-fiction books.

<u>Maths</u>

Number –

Fractions- identify equal and unequal parts.

Make tally charts and pictograms

Measurement -

Time- recognise o'clock, half past, quarter past & quarter to. To describe movement and turns

Science

Plants-

Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Gardens –

Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals.

Art: Printmaking (mono print)

Develop drawing and mark making skills, by drawing from photographs, film and closely observed objects.

DT: Healthy food

Design some new recipes only using fruits and vegetables, making sure they are colourful, tasty and healthy.

RE: Christianity & Sikhism

What are the Christian rites of passage? What do Sikhs believe?

Computing: Digital Music & programming

Compare creating music digitally and non-digitally. Design and create to create quiz questions in ScratchJr.

<u>French</u>

Respond to words and phrases in familiar stories. The learning context is the book 'J'habite a la ferme' and role play asking for ice-creams.

<u>Music</u>

Perform rhythmical patterns and accompaniments, keeping a steady pulse.

<u>PSHE</u>

What makes a good friend? Who are your special people?

VALUES – This term we will be learning about the values of Integrity and Resilience.

History: Significant Explorers

Select information independently from different types of sources including written, visual and oral sources and artefacts to answer historical questions. Know some of the ways that we can find about the recent past and also about explorers from long ago.
