Dear Parents and Carers

We had teachers visit the school on Thursday from the five other SWAN schools: Kingfield Primary, Beaufort Primary, The Horsell Village School, The Hermitage School and The Oaktree School. As a Trust, we work together to look for ways to continually improve our schools. Thursday was our 'Collaboration Day' and the teachers investigated two questions for us: 'How are children's skills to work scientifically being developed across the school?' and 'Are Knowledge Organisers being used effectively to support children to know more and remember more?'. We haven't received the formal reports yet, but had verbal feedback from the teams involved. The visiting teachers commented so positively about the attitudes and behaviours of the children and were complimentary about what we already have in place at school. They have given us a few pointers about how we could further develop.

Next Friday we will be holding a Creativity day in which children in all year groups will be immersed in dance, art, drama and music. Each year group will follow a different theme and learning opportunities will be developed around the theme. Do look out next week for photos of the day!

Setting the table: Help set the table for breakfast and dinner.


Make your bed each morning.
